<ul> <li>Timing</li> <li>Performed between 6-20 weeks of pregnancy</li> <li>Requires a more complex, longer procedure after 14 weeks of pregnancy</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Timing</li> <li>Ideally performed between 5-7 weeks of pregnancy</li> <li>Can be performed up to 9 weeks of pregnancy</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Timing</li> <li>Ideally performed between 5-7 weeks of pregnancy</li> <li>Can be performed up to 9 weeks of pregnancy</li> </ul>
Process  - Procedure performed in our operating room  - Performed under intravenous sedation (twilight)  - Pregnancy tissue is gently suctioned from the uterus using small, plastic tube  - Procedure generally takes 10-15 minutes but you will be in our clinic for a total of approximately 3 hours (including recovery time)  - You will need to take a dose of antibiotics at home (Clinic 66 will provide the prescription)  - May only require one clinic visit	<ul> <li>Process</li> <li>You visit the clinic and meet with a consultant who will do blood tests and ultrasound.</li> <li>First medication (Mifepristone) taken at the clinic and second medication (Misoprostol) taken at home 24-48 hours later which will induce a miscarriage.</li> <li>Leads to bleeding and cramping (ranging from mild to severe) which can last up to 3 weeks</li> <li>Follow up visit is required 3 weeks later with repeat ultrasound assessment to ensure the termination is complete</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Process</li> <li>You meet with a consultant online who will give you request forms for blood tests and ultrasound, which you will have done locally.</li> <li>You meet with the consultant again to review tests and she will provide you with prescriptions for the medication, which you will source locally.</li> <li>You will conduct the medical abortion at home (per 'Medical' option).</li> <li>10 days later you will have a second ultrasound done locally</li> <li>You will meet with the consultant online again 3 weeks later to ensure that all is well.</li> </ul>
Supports and Recovery  - It is ideal to have a support person to accompany you to the clinic and take you home after the procedure  - You are unable to drive 24 hours after sedation  - Afterwards, you will remain in our recovery room	<ul> <li>Support and Recovery</li> <li>It is highly recommended that you have someone to support you at home for at least the first 24 hours after taking the second set of medications</li> <li>Clinic 66 doctors can provide you with medications to assist with pain and cramping</li> </ul>	Support and Recovery  - It is highly recommended that you have someone to support you at home for at least the first 24 hours after taking the second set of medications  - The 24x7 MSHealth Help line is available for any
